SHOW REQUIREMENTS

1. **RULES/REGULATIONS:** Entries made in this division shall be subject to and each exhibitor agrees to abide by the General Rules and Regulations and Department Requirements as published in this exhibitor handbook. Pan American shows are open to any exhibitor, any age, from any state.
2. **ENTRY APPLICATION/FEE:** Entries must be completed entirely online. Online entry fee is \$5/entry with an additional \$5/head fee to enter the fur class.
3. **ADMISSION/PARKING:** All exhibitors are required to purchase an admission pass and parking permit for the duration of each show entered unless complimentary admission applies. Please see "Admission and Parking" in the General Rules Section of this Exhibitor Handbook. When a request for credentials to be mailed is indicated on the entry application and the mail fee is included with all other fees, passes will be mailed to the exhibitor. No credentials will be mailed after Opening Day. Credential delivery date is not guaranteed. All other credentials must be picked up in designated location after unloading. **ALL LIVESTOCK & POULTRY ARE REQUIRED TO ENTER THROUGH GATE 15.**
4. For points to count in the TRBA Sweepstakes series, exhibitor must be a member of the TRBA before the show starts.
5. The State Fair of Texas reserves the right to refuse entries from exhibitors placing an entry from all locations within 150 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.
6. **EAR MARKS:** All rabbits must have permanent and legible ear marks in left ear.
7. **LATE ENTRIES:** A \$25 fee will be added to each exhibitor's entry application submitted after entry deadline. NO late entries will be accepted after Opening Day of the Fair.
8. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitutions will be allowed only in the same breed, class, sex and color.
9. **JUDGING:** Rabbits will be judged by coop number. All exhibitors are responsible for presenting their animals at the judging table.
10. **FUR CLASSES:** Exhibitors must enter a breed class in order to enter a fur class. A separate entry fee applies.
11. **COOPS:** All entries will be expected to be in their assigned coops at all times during the show except when on the judging table.
12. **BREEDING:** No breeding will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
13. **MEAT PENS AND LITTERS:** No meat pens or does and litters will be allowed in the show.
14. Grooming tables and chairs will be allowed in designated areas only.
15. All exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their own animals.
16. **COMMENT CARDS AND RIBBONS:** Exhibitors must pick up comment cards and ribbons from the Secretary before leaving. They will not be mailed.
17. **RELEASE:** No releases will be written until published release time.
18. **POINT SYSTEM:** All displays will be determined by the ARBA point system as follows:
 - 1st: 6 points x number of rabbits in class
 - 2nd: 4 points x number of rabbits in class
 - 3rd: 3 points x number of rabbits in class
 - 4th: 2 points x number of rabbits in class
 - 5th: 1 point x number of rabbits in class

2. **ENTRY APPLICATION/FEE:** Entries must be completed entirely online. Online entry fee is \$5/entry with an additional \$5/head fee to enter the fur class.
3. **EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all exhibitors 18 years or younger as of September 1 of the current year. Entries will not be made through Ag Science Teachers or County Extension Agents.
4. **ADMISSION/PARKING:** All exhibitors are required to purchase an admission pass and parking permit for the duration of each show entered unless complimentary admission applies. Please see "Admission and Parking" in the General Rules Section of this Exhibitor Handbook. When a request for credentials to be mailed is indicated on the entry application and the mail fee is included with all other fees, passes will be mailed to the exhibitor.
