TRBA OFFICER AND DIRECTOR REPORTS

President Jeff Tondre



Howdy from South Central Texas! I am Jeff Tondre, the new TRBA President. First, thank you to Teresa and Beth for their leadership over the past four years. With both of their terms now complete, I am especially grateful that Teresa will continue as the Advisor. Her guidance will be valuable as my role begins. I also want to thank my wife, Amber, for her four years of service as Secretary. Supporting her during that time was both fun and challenging. I learned a lot about how our Club operates. Hearing the good and bad from her involvement inspired a desire to help make some improvements. Serving as President felt like the best way to help guide those changes.

Thanks to Amy for returning to the Board and Katie for coming on Board as a secretary. I nominated Kayla Strain to fill the Director position that had no applicants, and the Board approved the appointment. I am looking forward to working with all the returning, new, and renewing Board members. Congratulations to all the winners from the recent contests. As posted on Facebook, the 66th Annual State Show and Meeting are now in the rearview mirror. Planning has already started for the next three shows, leading up to next year's State Show. These shows take a massive number of volunteers. Some spend nearly a year planning. We are always looking for help, even if it is just an hour or two at the show. All help is appreciated to lighten the load for everyone. I started in rabbits back in 1977, but my involvement increased when my young family began attending shows. As the kids became more independent—aside from needing a chauffeur and someone to carry the heavy stuff—I found too much time on my hands, and I am not the type to sit and watch others work. Doing something meaningful is more appealing. With my youngest daughter heading to college this year, I expect to have more time again.

By profession, I am a licensed professional engineer with over 30 years of experience solving problems and managing projects from concept to completion. That experience translates well to helping manage Club issues. I tend to focus on challenges first and think about social graces second. I appreciate your patience with that.

The Club seems to be functioning well overall. One of the first things I would like to focus on is Club finances. I understand the Club had serious financial challenges in the early 2010s, but that no longer seems to be the case—due largely to financial frugality. The current approach leans heavily on minimizing expenses and maximizing profit.

Based on the financial report from the Annual Meeting, the Club ended last year with about \$42,000 in the bank and made a profit close to \$15,000. The scholarship fund holds \$72,000. At the banquet, \$1,500 was distributed in youth scholarships, and more money was raised than was given. That is a good problem to have.

As a nonprofit, the goal should not be to endlessly make money. The focus should be on giving back to the membership in meaningful ways. A big step is developing a proper budget. Through Amber's service, it became clear that TRBA has operated without an annual budget for almost a decade. That needs to change. A budget helps plan our spending and track expenses. It keeps things from swinging too far in either direction. To start this, I have created an emergency committee to develop an initial budget made up of the Executive Board. I also called for a permanent Budget Committee made up of past TRBA Presidents. As we plan a budget, my proposed idea is to use some of the profit to improve prizes at shows—such as offering awards for ALL (not just the top 5, 10 or 15 breeds) BOB and BOS winners. Also, to look at possibly giving ribbons for youth class placements. Experienced exhibitors may not care about ribbons, but for a young member placing fourth for the first time, that ribbon matters. It is something they will hang on the wall. We do not need to spend a fortune. We can even create a system where exhibitors who do not want ribbons can recycle them—say, after getting a photo.

I have asked our Scholarship Committee to begin reviewing the current award structure. If we were to stop raising funds today—which is not the plan—we currently have enough money in the bank to continue awarding scholarships at current levels every year until a child born this year reaches their senior year of high school. That does not make sense to me.

Other initiatives are in the works and will be introduced over time. One of the first actions taken was forming a committee to better represent the Cavy exhibitors. As a new cavy exhibitor, it is clear this part of the Club is often overlooked when planning rabbit shows. With the approval of the Board, Leanna Herzog was nominated to chair the committee. I will be working with her to fill out the group and define its responsibilities.

I also want to take steps to support and strengthen Texas's All-Breed Clubs. We are down to eight statewide. There used to be nearly 30. Too much of Texas is no longer covered by local clubs, which limits where shows are and how we bring in the next generation of exhibitors.

All committee appointments are up for review in early spring in odd-numbered years. Some committee members have been asked to continue. Some still need to be contacted. Some positions will need to be filled. All nominations are subject to Board approval. That process will unfold over the next couple of months. If you have a special talent or interest and want to get involved, please reach out to me directly.

Katie probably will not love how long this message is. I still have a few website updates to finish before calling it a night, so I am wrapping up here. Keep the upcoming TRBA show in Longview in mind. See you at the show, and I would like to hear your ideas on making the good Club even better for you, its members.

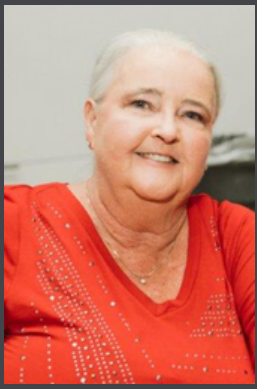
Howdy Folks!

One of the youth-driven events we will continue is the Summer Traveling Youth Workshops. They will be back this summer during June-July, so stay tuned for when and where! I'm hoping to have 3-5 workshops and we will work with the Youth Committee to make them a success again. When my daughter started showing five years ago, I just wanted something for her to be involved in. She wasn't interested in sports, cheer, dance, or the typical activities other kids her age were drawn to—she simply loved animals. With her whole heart, she wanted nothing more than to care for them. So, she joined 4-H.

Through 4-H, we discovered the world of showing animals and decided to start with rabbits. What began with just two rabbits has grown into a full-blown passion—our barn is now bursting at the seams, and feed is delivered by the pallet. But more than anything, those two rabbits gave my daughter something far greater: responsibility, passion, work ethic, and leadership skills I never could have imagined.

Her mornings look very different from those of her peers. She wakes up early to feed, water, and check on her ever-growing menagerie before heading to school or practice.

Her evenings and weekends are spent grooming, feeding, cleaning, and managing breeding schedules—before making time for friends. Sometimes, she has to skip fun events because they fall on a show weekend. And while those choices are hard, they've made her into a responsible and dedicated young woman.

I want other parents to understand that raising and showing livestock teaches responsibility in a way few other activities can. At first, my daughter needed my help with nearly everything. But slowly, each task became hers alone. These days, I'm mostly just her chauffeur—and financial support (though I'm hoping she'll take over that role one day too!). As parents, we need to step back and let our young showmen take ownership of their animals. It's how we guide them into becoming strong, capable leaders. When parents do everything for their kids, they unintentionally rob them of the invaluable life lessons this hobby offers.

The ribbons and awards are nice—but they're not the real reward. If she doesn't take time to groom and prepare, her rabbits don't place well. If she fails to check for illness, DQs, or proper nutrition, she loses stock. And those moments, while tough, are where the real learning happens. They teach her how to reflect, adapt, and improve.

I consider myself lucky that my child found her passion in showing. It's not always easy, but the lessons she's learned will serve her for a lifetime. She's developed grit, problem-solving skills, adaptability, and meaningful connections with both peers and adults. From the 8-year-old who began showing during the COVID-19 shutdown to the young lady she is now—she's come such a long way. And I have two little rabbits to thank for starting it all.

Official TRBA Sweepstakes Rules

Eligibility

To qualify for the TRBA Sweepstakes Contests, exhibitor must be an individual member of the TRBA and live in the State of Texas or adjoining states of New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Louisiana.

A member will receive a 30-day grace period to renew TRBA membership without sweepstakes penalty. If TRBA membership is not renewed within 30 days, any points previously earned will be forfeited. Points will start over on the new date of membership.

Contest Calculations

The contest will include all TRBA Sanctioned Shows held from January 1st to December 31st each year. Only shows held in Texas and sanctioned with TRBA will be counted. Points to be figured on basis of Show Secretary's Report as submitted to the TRBA Sweepstakes Chairperson.

Exhibitors will receive points for the categories that are entered. Youth exhibitors will not be able to transfer their Open shows points to the youth totals. The points will be added based on the category (Open or Youth) entered in that show. Points to be tabulated regularly and the top five (5) of each breed to be published in the TRBA Newsletter.

Points to be counted only as follows based on class placements. There are no points awarded for specials earned (BIS, BOB, BOG, BOV, etc). Points stay within the breed contest. No overall standings contest.

- 1st place receives 6 times the number in class.
- 2nd place receives 4 times the number in class.
- 3rd place receives 3 times the number in class.
- 4th place receives 2 times the number in class.
- 5th place receives 1 time the number in class.

Awards

Sweepstakes Awards are to be bought by the TRBA by utilizing the 25% show tax funds collected from the hosting clubs. The following minimum requirements must be met to be eligible for a breed sweepstakes award. The Sweepstakes awards will be presented at the Annual State Show Banquet.
