ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Mid-Tex RBA is an Early Entry Control Sheet Show. No comment cards.
- Entries will be accepted by EMAIL only.
- Ensure your entry includes an exhibitor name, address, phone number and the show(s) being entered.
- Please NO Photo entries. Use our entry form, another system generated form or type in the body of the email. Anything handwritten MUST BE LEGIBLE.

YOUTH

- May not enter the same animal in both open and youth at the same show. This means that an animal may be shown in the Youth Show OR Open Show but not both.
- Anyone may show in an Open Show regardless of age.
- Only those exhibitors between the ages of 5 and 18 may show in the Youth Shows. If an exhibitor is 4 years old or 19 years old, they MUST show in the Open show.



IDENTIFICATION

All entries must have a permanent and legible ear identification in the left ear. Animals not properly marked will be disqualified from the show and no entry fee refunded.

FUF

All animals will be judged in breed fur unless otherwise noted.

ARBA REGISTRAR

A Licensed ARBA Rabbit Registrar will be available. This is a completely optional service separate from entering the show. ARBA Registrations include inspecting the animal for DQs, weighing the animal, and filling out paperwork to be included in ARBA's database. This process is required to obtain any Grand Champion certificates from ARBA.

- \$6 fee for each rabbit you want to register with the ARBA

RULES & LIABLITY



ARBA RULES & LIABILITY

This show is held in strict accordance with the latest and revised Official Show Rules of ARBA. Filing of an entry indicates acceptance of ARBA and Mid-Tex RBA show rules. As per ARBA Show Rules, Mid-Tex RBA MUST refuse entries from within 50/25 miles of a confirmed domestic/wild outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within 30 days of entry deadline. All parties in attendance will each individually assume all risk and liabilities. Bell County Expo Center, ARBA, TRBA, Mid-Tex RBA and members of the show committee will not be liable for any accident, illness, death, injury, damage, or harm to exhibitors or their animals, which may result from attending this show. All precautions will be taken for a safe show.

HEALTH

- Animals showing symptoms of disease of any kind WILL NOT be allowed admittance to the show room. Show management is compelled to refuse entry to show room and remove from the same, all diseased or unsightly animals. Any animals displaying white nasal discharge must be removed immediately and will not be allowed to compete in any additional shows. All entry fees on such animals shall be forfeited.
- All animals must be healthy and in proper-size leakproof transport cages to ensure the animals' well-being. No coops will be provided.
- No does with litters will be allowed on the show premises.
- RHDV2 Vaccinations are not a requirement for entry.
- As of this catalog date, Texas does not require health certificates for entry. Exhibitors are to consult their current state regulations for any rabbit travel restrictions prior to departure.

NO ANIMALS OTHER THAN ENTERED RABBITS AND CAVIES OR CERTIFIED WORKING SERVICE ANIMALS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING. SERVICE ANIMALS CAUSING DISRUPTION WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

CONDUCT

- The decisions of the judges will be final.
- Youth & Adult Exhibitors must act in a professional manner towards judges, show committee, show help & each other.
- Any exhibitor indicating ownership, harassing, or interfering with a judge or writer will be disqualified & forfeit all fees/winnings.
- No video recording without approval from the judge.
- Behaviors perceived as unbeneficial for the show & exhibitors will not be tolerated.
- Only show officials, judges and designated writers are allowed in the judging area.
- Parents are responsible and accountable for the actions/damages of their children. If any damages occur, you will be financially responsible for the repair or replacement of the damages.
- No skateboards, roller skates, rollerblades, scooters, etc. are allowed in the building.
- Any exhibitor wishing to file a formal protest must make a \$150 payment to Mid-Tex RBA to be heard by the show committee

JUDGING

- Exhibitors or their designee are responsible for getting their rabbits to the show table.
- Youth rabbits must be carried to the show table by a youth (5—18 years old). Adults are not to place rabbits on or off the show table for youth shows.
- Absolutely NO REFUNDS of entry fees will be made.
- We will make 3 calls from the judging table and then those present will be judged.
- Judging for the second show may start before the first show finishes. Be listening for your breed so that you are not passed over for judging.
- Best in Show will be chosen at the end of the day after the completion of all shows.
- Awards must be picked up the day of the show.
- Exhibitor show reports and legs will be EMAILED within 30 days after the conclusion of the show.



No product pre-orders or deliveries may be at the show site without permission to be in the building.



FREQUENTY ASKED QUESTIONS



HOW DO I ENTER THE SHOW?

Entries are only accepted via email. You can attach an entry form document or type in the body of the message. Include your name, address, breed, variety, class, and tattoo. An auto-reply message will be sent when your entry has arrived in our inbox. A confirmation will be emailed to you after processing.

WHERE CAN I FIND ENTRY FORMS?

Entry forms are included on the "Files Tab" of the Mid-Tex RBA Shows Facebook Group, and the last pages of the show catalog that will be posted on the ARBA & TRBA websites.

MAY I ENTER THE DAY OF THE SHOW?

NOT AS A NEW EXHIBITOR.
You MUST be entered by the deadline to participate. NO EXCEPTIONS. ARBA Show Rules has a restriction for those residing within a RHDV2 quarantine zone. The entry deadline allows us to confirm all exhibitors are eligible to show. You may add new animals to existing entries upon arrival.

CAN I MAKE CHANGES TO MY ENTRY AFTER INITIALLY SENDING IN?

Yes. Changes are free through the change deadline. After the deadline, they will be made upon arrival, unless an input error identified prior to printing.

DO I HAVE TO ENTER ALL SHOWS?

No. You can enter one, two, or all three. However, you must abide by the entry/check-in deadlines.

MAY I ENTER MARKET CLASSES?

Yes. There are classes for Meatpens, Single Fryers, Roasters, & Stewers for each show. Mid-Tex is not hosting a jackpot at this time. Awards will be provided by Mid-Tex if a class includes 15+ entries.

WHAT IS A FUR CLASS?

This is an optional class judged at the conclusion of the breed based only on fur. The animal must be entered in the breed class to enter fur. National breed clubs offer a fur sweepstakes. This is open to all recognized ARBA breeds.

HOW DO I PAY ENTRY FEES?

Upon arrival at check-in.

Cash, Check payable to Mid-Tex RBA, or
Credit Card (3% Square Fee Added)

No prepayment accepted

IS THERE A LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES?

No. You may enter as many animals as you would like. The entry fee is per animal per show.





FREQUENTY ASKED QUESTIONS



DO I HAVE TO BE AN ARBA/TRBA MEMBER?

No. Being a member of the American Rabbit Breeders
Association (ARBA) and Texas Rabbit Breeders
Association (TRBA) provides benefits such as
participating in sweepstakes points contests.
However, it is not a requirement to enter the show.

WHAT IS A TATTOO? WILL ANYONE BE ABLE TO TATTOO MY RABBIT AT THE SHOW?

ARBA requires each rabbit to have a permanent identification tattoo in their left ear or the animal will be disqualified. If your rabbit needs a tattoo, several exhibitors attending the show will offer tattoo services. However, it is recommended to tattoo prior to the show as you will need the tattoo identification to complete your entry.

WHAT SUPPLIES DO I NEED TO BRING?

Animals in their travel cages, feed/water for the day, any grooming supplies (brushes, etc.), Lawn chairs to sit in while waiting to show, Cash/checkbook to pay for entry fees, raffle, concession, purchase supplies from vendor, etc.

WHAT ARE ARBA/TRBA SANCTIONS?

Mid-Tex RBA has sanctioned all shows with the American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) and Texas Rabbit Breeders Association (TRBA). These sanctions allow you to become eligible to receive ARBA legs and accumulate points for the TRBA sweepstakes points contests.

WHAT ARE SANCTIONED BREEDS? MY BREED ISN'T LISTED. CAN I STILL SHOW?

Yes. All breeds recognized by the ARBA (or have ARBA Certificates of Development) may be shown. Sanctioned breeds allow exhibitors that are members of the breed's National Organizations (National Havana Club, etc.) to be eligible for sweepstakes points based on the placements at the show. Mid-Tex will send show reports to the National Breed Clubs.

CAN I SANCTION MY BREED?

Yes. Please contact Mid-Tex RBA secretary a month prior to the show date.

Any requests closer to the show date will depend on the National Breed Club's acceptance

IS A HEALTH CERTIFICATE REQUIRED?

As of this catalog date, Texas does not require health certificates for entry. Exhibitors are to consult their current state regulations for any rabbit travel restrictions prior to departure.

DO MY RABBITS NEED TO BE VACCINATED FOR RHD?

No. Vaccinations are not a requirement for entry.







FREQUENTY ASKED QUESTIONS



WHAT IS THE BARN ENVIRONMENT?

The show will be held in the Exposition Building .The 55,000 sf building features a concrete floor, large fans, strong ventilation system, permanent sound system, state of the art lighting, and is air-conditioned. Ample restrooms are available, and concessions will be sold by the Expo Center.

Parking is free.

WHO WILL JUDGE MY ANIMALS?

The ARBA licensed judges hired by the club are listed in this show catalog. Any of them could judge your animals for any given show. Judges are given breeds as determined by the superintendent to keep the show moving. A judge will only judge that particular breed once during the weekend.

WHEN WILL MY ANIMALS SHOW?

Breeds are judged with the largest number of entries first. There is no specific designated time schedule as the time to judge a breed will vary by the number of entries. 7PM Friday & 8AM Saturday are the start times. The Saturday afternoon show will begin promptly after all breeds entered in the morning show have been judged. Usually breeds begin the afternoon show around lunch hour.

MAY I LEAVE MY ANIMALS IN THE BARN OVERNIGHT?

Friday — Yes
Saturday — No, the building must be vacated at conclusion of the show.

IS THERE A HOTEL BLOCK?

No. There are many different hotels available close to the show barn. You should be able to find one that will best fit all your requirements.

ARE THERE RV HOOKUPS?

Yes. Contact the venue for more information.

WILL THERE BE AN ARBA REGISTRAR PRESENT?

Yes. Mid-Tex members Amber & Krystal Tondre will be available. Contact them for more information and to ensure they bring enough forms.

DO I NEED PEDIGREES?

No. Pedigrees are not a requirement for showing. You may want to bring them if you plan to register the rabbit with the ARBA.
