There are plenty of ways to do it that will suit your budget. Ac, swamper, fans, ice pack and mister have all been used. Just be mindful if your method has a stressor that can affect the bunnies growth. Extreme heat will cut food consumption and that will affect growth. Also the heat affects ear length as it is how the bunny cools itself. If your breed has ear limits be mindful of that also. Your potential fall show team can be eliminated for too long ears. Fur can't be damaged by hutch stains and take a good bit to molt out. Sometimes longer than the bunnies show season.

There are many breeders that use the methods I mention. If you're having issues, please seek out for advice. Keeping it short as we await the arrival of our first grand child at the hospital.

Keep nest boxes full of best in show bunnies.

I would compare them to 4 week old rabbits. In the end, the turnaround time is surprisingly similar.

I am excited to continue learning more about cavies and am especially looking forward to showing my Abyssinians at ARBA Convention in Reno this October. It will be a new experience, and I can't wait to see how they do. As summer continues, I hope everyone is staying cool and enjoying time with their animals. As the summer heats up, we have a new disease threat to our rabbit herds developing across the state of TX, Screwworm. Screwworms are a once eradicated disease that is once again making itself known in TX. They are a maggot (fly larvae) that eats living flesh of warm-blooded animals. Several counties across TX have now had reported cases. This disease is reportable and rabbits are susceptible, along with other livestock. The state is placing some counties under quarantine for all warm-blooded animals and some states are adding restrictions to states affected with screwworm. It is vital for our livestock industries that we help monitor screwworms and report any possible cases.

Here are the big takeaways that every breeder should follow:

- 1) Practice Fly Control
- 2) Report any cases of maggots in rabbits (not in poop or in cages) to a veterinarian or the Texas Animal Health Commission
- 3) Do not treat maggots found on rabbits without first consulting a veterinarian or the TAHC
- 4) Check with TAHC or the USDA for travel restrictions before travelling to shows

From the Texas Animal Health Commission:

Warm-blooded animals moving outside of an infested zone must contact the TAHC to set up an inspection. During this inspection, an animal health official will fill out an animal movement certificate listing the product used for prevention or treatment and the animals' official ID. This certificate will need to accompany the animal movement. Additional guidance can be provided during an initial inspection request call to TAHC and general guidance can be referenced in the Livestock Movement from a NWS-Infested Zone handout.

Official TRBA Sweepstakes Rules

Eligibility

To qualify for the TRBA Sweepstakes Contests, exhibitor must be an individual member of the TRBA and live in the State of Texas or adjoining states of New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Louisiana.

A member will receive a 30-day grace period to renew TRBA membership without sweepstakes penalty. If TRBA membership is not renewed within 30 days, any points previously earned will be forfeited. Points will start over on the new date of membership.

Contest Calculations

The contest will include all TRBA Sanctioned Shows held from January 1st to December 31st each year. Only shows held in Texas and sanctioned with TRBA will be counted. Points to be figured on basis of Show Secretary's Report as submitted to the TRBA Sweepstakes Chairperson.

Exhibitors will receive points for the categories that are entered. Youth exhibitors will not be able to transfer their Open shows points to the youth totals. The points will be added based on the category (Open or Youth) entered in that show. Points to be tabulated regularly and the top five (5) of each breed to be published in the TRBA Newsletter.

Points to be counted only as follows based on class placements. There are no points awarded for specials earned (BIS, BOB, BOG, BOV, etc). Points stay within the breed contest. No overall standings contest.

- 1st place receives 6 times the number in class.
- 2nd place receives 4 times the number in class.
- 3rd place receives 3 times the number in class.
- 4th place receives 2 times the number in class.
- 5th place receives 1 time the number in class.

Awards

Sweepstakes Awards are to be bought by the TRBA by utilizing the 25% show tax funds collected from the hosting clubs. The following minimum requirements must be met to be eligible for a breed sweepstakes award. The Sweepstakes awards will be presented at the Annual State Show Banquet.
