

Then you can work with someone new and get them comfortable taking comments, as well. See one, do one, show one. Y'all – if you REALLY want to impress the show secretaries, put the breed sheets back in numerical order before turning the folders in... For those of you who already do this at shows, don't think you go unnoticed!

On that note, I think there are several show secretaries who wouldn't mind help in the office – even from older youth exhibitors. I know that I have been lucky to have a few youth that offer to help throughout shows, and I love that!! Do you know why? Because that is how the next generation learns! Please don't be afraid to poke your head into a secretary's office and offer to help.

Hello TRBA members.



I'm sure thankful that the winter has cooperated so far. It was nice for our county fair not to be impacted by an ice storm warning for the first time in several years.

Speaking of our county fair, we had over 300 breeding rabbits, 92 meatpens, and 80 single fryers. This was the first year for our kiddos with single fryers to make the action. We also had many participants in the showmanship and judging contests.

I know that there has been great anxiety over feed availability issues. I have spoken with many who are exploring freighting feed directly from the mills. I have a great amount of experience since I have been doing this since 2006. Here are my top tips:

- Make sure that the person who is arranging shipping knows that you are shipping to a
 residential area. That may determine if a company can even deliver to you. Unless you have a
 forklift, you will need a lift gate on the trailer. This also increases the cost.
- 2. Make sure the person shipping sends you numbers to track the shipment with. My feed company sends a copy of the BOL document with everything that I need. The trucking company has a site that you can enter the PRO number into and see the shipment's location. The shipping company we are currently using sends a text with the PRO and a request for us to call to schedule the delivery. If this is not an option, ask for a call prior to delivery so you can be prepared.
- All feed from the Midwest will go through Chicago. You will need to allow at least an extra week during the winter. We had feed sit in Chicago for over two weeks during Sno-vid in 2021. Trucks just couldn't get in and out.
- 4. I have been through probably 10 trucking companies. I had one declare my driveway unsafe after they had been delivering on it for five years! You name it, I have had it happen. You can request certain shippers. Get to know the shipping agent for your feed company well. A few dollars can make the difference in getting your delivery undamaged and in a timely manner.
- If you have damaged feed, be sure to let the feed company know. They need to place a claim and credit your account.
- 6. The more pallets you ship, the entire process will be cheaper.
- Be patient and order about two weeks before you will need feed! Crazy things can happen anytime of the year.

I know that many of us are planning treks to the spring national shows. May the fur cooperate and everyone have a safe trip! If you just need to experience a national, the Rex, New Zealand, and Holland Lop National Shows will be in Belton from April 19-21. We will not say no to help setting the cooping up and taking down, running rabbits, etc.

Sweepstakes Update 2024

Greetings from your new Sweepstakes Chair! <u>Thank-you</u> for your patience and understanding during this transition year. You will find a new version of the Sweepstakes Rules included in this newsletter. This was designed to add clarifications for the membership to understand the process better. Several questions have been repeatedly received over the last few months and I wanted to take a moment to highlight the key elements as we head into a fresh new year.

TRBA MEMBERSHIP STATUS:

- Keep it current and don't let it lapse past the <u>30-day</u> grace period to renew. Beginning in 2024, once the <u>30-day</u> grace period has expired, YOU FORFEIT any previously earned points. Sweepstakes is a benefit of being a member. You are technically removed from the membership database by the secretary and no longer considered a member once the grace period expires.
- Membership is managed by Amber Tondre, TRBA Secretary. I rely off the membership listing she provides
 me. If there are issues regarding membership, address them with her. I will correct on the sweepstakes side
 upon receipt of the next updated membership listing. The majority of questions received as to why not being
 listed in the standings is due to lack of current membership status.

SHOW SECRETARY REMINDERS:

- Please enter exhibitors exactly as they submit the entries. Don't just rely on what you have as a previous
 entry. If there is a difference in names, that results in a different exhibitor for sweepstakes purposes.
- If you are uncertain if your show sanction request was received, contact Amber to resolve. Only shows
 included on the TRBA sanctioned shows report will be counted.
- All secretaries have 30 days to submit their reports. After that, late penalties are assessed at the state level to
 be counted for sweepstakes. Ensure that you submit your show reports data to <u>SWEEPS@TRBA.NET</u> in
 addition to sending in the show fees and forms to Amber.

SWEEPSTAKES CALCULATIONS:

- Only standard ARBA class points are awarded. Your show reports may display additional points that are awarded by National Breed clubs for winning BIS, BOB, BOV, etc. Each breed club has a different methodology and those points are not included in Texas sweepstakes.
- Shows must have been sanctioned by the hosting club to count. Just because a show is held in Texas, does
 not automatically make it Texas sanctioned. A_majority_of the Texas shows do get sanctioned, however if
 you are ever uncertain, ask the hosting club.

SWEEPSTAKES STANDINGS

- I am committing to providing you with quarterly standings updates.
- The top 5 of each breed will be displayed. Simply put, it takes time to confirm membership for everyone.
 This allows to prioritize just the top end of each breed to generate results quicker.
- The shows included in the standings, missing reports and shows you may have attended that aren't yet due
 to have their reports sent in yet are displayed. It will be listed Every time. If you attended a show that is not
 listed and you believe should be, reach out. The sooner the better. Let's not wait until December to realize a
 show from February is not included.

AWARDS

- 400+ Points for Rabbit Exhibitors, 250+ Points for Cavy Exhibitors
- Top 2 Every Breed that meets points thresholds

QUESTIONS

Please reach out to me via SWEEPS@TRBA.NET. Having your question in writing in that account allows me to ensure it is addressed when I am around the sweepstakes spreadsheet and can actually research it. Sending them other ways can get lost or unintentionally forgotten. Please remember that I am human and have taken on many responsibilities in life (rabbit related and work). I am making every effort to respond timely upon having all the necessary information. Membership questions that come to me do have to be confirmed and resolved by the TRBA secretary before I can proceed.

Keep showing those animals and earning Texas points! As of writing this article, there have been nearly 51,000 entries at Texas shows in 2023 and not all shows data has been received yet. I'll provide the membership with the full report of 2023 at the membership meeting at State Show.

Official TRBA Sweepstakes Rules



Eligibility

To qualify for the TRBA Sweepstakes Contests, exhibitor must be an individual member of the TRBA and live in the State of Texas or adjoining states of New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Louisiana.

A member will receive a 30-day grace period to renew TRBA membership without sweepstakes penalty. If TRBA membership is not renewed within 30 days, any points previously earned will be forfeited. Points will start over on the new date of membership.

Contest Calculations

The contest will include all TRBA Sanctioned Shows held from January 1st to December 31st each year. Only shows held in Texas and sanctioned with TRBA will be counted. Points to be figured on basis of Show Secretary's Report as submitted to the TRBA Sweepstakes Chairperson.

Exhibitors will receive points for the categories that are entered. Youth exhibitors will not be able to transfer their Open shows points to the youth totals. The points will be added based on the category (Open or Youth) entered in that show. Points to be tabulated regularly and the top five (5) of each breed to be published in the TRBA Newsletter.

Points to be counted only as follows based on class placements. There are no points awarded for specials earned (BIS, BOB, BOG, BOV, etc). Points stay within the breed contest. No overall standings contest.

1st place receives 6 times the number in class.

2nd place receives 4 times the number in class.

3rd place receives 3 times the number in class.

4th place receives 2 times the number in class.

5th place receives 1 time the number in class.

Awards

Sweepstakes Awards are to be bought by the TRBA by utilizing the 25% show tax funds collected from the hosting clubs. The following minimum requirements must be met to be eligible for a breed sweepstakes award. The Sweepstakes awards will be presented at the Annual State Show Banquet.

400+ points 5 TRBA Sanctioned Shows 1st place & 2nd place breed award

250+ points 3 TRBA Sanctioned Shows 1st place & 2nd place breed award

BLACK BUNNY GOLD

Black Bunny Gold

Now that we have hopefully all survived the past few months of crazy winter weather, we can turn our sights to some lovely spring weather! I don't know about y'all, but after our last summer of drought and heat here in Texas, my rabbits as well as my yard and gardens have suffered. My rabbits have had lots of trouble breeding and raising successful litters. I have dead patches of grass; I've lost rose bushes and am struggling to revive many long-established shrubs and perennials. Now that cooler temperatures and spring is here my rabbits are breeding again, raising babies and producing lots of black bunny gold!

I compost all my rabbit barn cleanings into usable fertile compost. I have 2 collapsible wire compost bins. Acquired many years ago from a local city program. But you can build your own compost bins using whatever materials and space that you have.

Rabbit manure is considered a "cold manure". You can spread it directly on top of your garden. Cold manures release nutrients slowly. Hot manures, like horse and cow, have so much nitrogen they will 'burn' the roots of plants, making the leaves brown and stunted rather than green and lush. These hot manures must always be composted with carbon-rich materials, like leaves or straw, before they are applied to the soil. Hot manures also produce a strong odor as they break down. The rabbit manure has little to no odor, your neighbors will appreciate that!

You can utilize rabbit manure as top dressing for your trees, garden beds or houseplants. Alternatively, you can work it into soil as a soil treatment. It is rich in nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium. Vital nutrients for plant growth and health. My rabbits are fed Timothy hay daily. So a lot of that hay ends up on the ground and is raked up along with the manure for the compost pile. I have both hanging cages as well as several stacked cages. The manure and hay from the hanging cages is raked up off the dirt floor. But in the stacked cage trays I use granular Sweet PDZ for odor control and Pine Pellets to absorb the urine. Both are safe for composting.

All of it goes in the big wire bin. I also add my kitchen scraps that I collect in a closed container. Coffee grounds, eggshells, veggie scrapings and other discarded peels, fruits and vegetables. Sometimes I use some of the barn floor scrapings to put directly in the garden. So that is just manure and hay. The fresh manure gets tilled into the garden bed and left to sit about a week before I put my transplants in (tomatoes, peppers in the summer-kale, parsley, fennel in the fall). When the big wire bin is full, I pull the wire bin up to remove it and break down the big pile with my tiller. It takes a few weeks of repeated tilling until the pile really starts to break down. I then call a friend who comes and loads it up and hauls it away. I have traded my Black Bunny Gold for discounted auto repairs, help with barn repairs, small home repair projects and whatever I can think of! Or I use it to add to my flower beds, use as mulch around bushes and trees and spread over my lawn to help revive the grass from the summer stress. I also send feed bags full of it home with my daughter and friends for their garden beds.
