I've occasionally had to make announcements (and later adjustments) to help fit everyone in. Your cooperation makes the experience better for all.

Looking ahead:

 - Youth Scholarship applications are due February 1st.
 - Youth Royalty applications will follow soon after.

 - Annual State Show – Belton, March 20–22, 2026

Howdy Folks!

We are heading into a whirl-wind fall lineup! I know my crew will be traveling quite a bit in the next 7-9 weeks (between judging, convention, secretary work, and another workshop in Gatesville - I'm booked!). Not to mention that pesky "real job" that pays the bills...

I'm sure we are all in mid-preparation for Convention, praying coats come in and the fur-confetti ceases! Since this newsletter will come out right before, I figured I would include a few tips for those of use who may be first timers! Order (AND READ!) the catalog! It will have all the details about coop decor, time schedules, rules, meetings, contests, and extra tidbits that will be a lifesaver come travel time. You do not *have* to have the physical copy - the digital is more handy in my experience. Plan your travel so you have some breaks along the way; rabbits tend to not eat/drink while on the road. Our family typically arrives on Thursday so the "crazy" builds around the rabbits as folks arrive (rather than plopping them into chaos after a huge drive).

Convention does supply feed - but just in case they run low (or you feed something not-as-common), do bring your own. Whether you choose to feed yours or the supplied bags is up to you when you get there, but at least you'll know 100% your feed is available. Don't change up treats/conditioner right before you go ~ if your bunnies are finished, keep them on their regimen! As entry deadline approaches, do know you will be able to make some changes, but not extreme ones (breed changes can't happen after entry and as we get closer, only ear tattoo changes will be allowed). As you load in, take your time. Prep each cage first before trying to put animals in then setting up the cage. It's much easier to put the rabbit in a prepared 'home' than it is to try to arrange furniture around them. Remember to clean your cages frequently - if we can work together with cage hygiene, it will help keep the smell in the building at a minimum. For cleaning, my family uses hand brooms, an inexpensive trash bin from Dollar Tree, and a single hole carrier to keep buns in while cleaning is in progress. Although sometimes things can be stressful (usually caused by self-induced time limits), remember you're there for FUN! Volunteer where you can, enjoy your time, and make wise decisions - we want everyone back in Texas 100% healthy! (This is your reminder to pack [and use!!!] hand sanitizer!).

For our youth - **GOOD LUCK!!!!** Remember your team activities come first in the schedule - if you're scheduled for 2 things at the same time, team takes priority - they are good about adjusting as needed! Remember to pack some "professional" attire for royalty interviews! Remember this is fun and although you may feel stressed - those evaluating you **WANT YOU TO SUCCEED!** The judges aren't scary! Review your initial applications so you can remember what you wrote. Relax, smile, make eye contact, and give a firm handshake! If you're not doing royalty - do your best on your contests - that's all anyone can ask!

I'm sure I'll be seeing most folks throughout the fall - excited for a great show season!

Most of all, it's disheartening to see new families misled by sellers who take advantage of their inexperience and enthusiasm.

As a rabbit community, we are working to change that story. We face real challenges from backyard breeders offering rabbits cheaply and unethically, but we also see so much good happening. I'm encouraged by the fall workshops and expos that are helping to place excellent rabbits in the hands of new exhibitors, giving them the strong start they deserve. I'm grateful for the breeders who refer families to us, and I make it a priority to connect new youth with reputable breeders I've met at shows. When we share reliable breeder contacts widely and support each other, we strengthen the future of our industry.

And when kids do come to county shows with rabbits that aren't competitive, our role is to meet them with encouragement. Even if we can't provide them with a winning rabbit, we can offer information, resources, and connections. What matters most is that these families feel welcomed and supported so they stay engaged, rather than leaving the rabbit project behind after one discouraging experience.

We may not be able to mentor every single youth, but we can all make a greater impact by working together, sharing resources, and extending support. If we focus on building more positive first experiences, we can help ensure that tomorrow's rabbit breeders and exhibitors remain excited, motivated, and proud to be part of our community. That's a goal worth striving toward this season—and beyond.

Official TRBA Sweepstakes Rules

Eligibility

To qualify for the TRBA Sweepstakes Contests, exhibitor must be an individual member of the TRBA and live in the State of Texas or adjoining states of New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Louisiana.

A member will receive a 30-day grace period to renew TRBA membership without sweepstakes penalty. If TRBA membership is not renewed within 30 days, any points previously earned will be forfeited. Points will start over on the new date of membership.

Contest Calculations

The contest will include all TRBA Sanctioned Shows held from January 1st to December 31st each year. Only shows held in Texas and sanctioned with TRBA will be counted. Points to be figured on basis of Show Secretary's Report as submitted to the TRBA Sweepstakes Chairperson.

The points will be added based on the category (Open or Youth) entered in that show. Points to be tabulated regularly and the top five (5) of each breed to be published in the TRBA Newsletter.

Points to be counted only as follows based on class placements. There are no points awarded for specials earned (BIS, BOB, BOG, BOV, etc). Points stay within the breed contest. No overall standings contest.

- 1st place receives 6 times the number in class.
- 2nd place receives 4 times the number in class.
- 3rd place receives 3 times the number in class.
- 4th place receives 2 times the number in class.
- 5th place receives 1 time the number in class.
